- **Pages:** Number of pages if stapled or glued.
- **Despatch:** **A, G, N, S:** Item may be sent direct from Adelaide, Gold Coast, N Canberra, Sydney.

Orders placed by email will be acknowledged within 5 days. If no acknowledgement is received, please re-send the order, as there may have been a breakdown in email transmission.

Limited Stock items are marked with an * in the first column in the Distribution List, beside the Item Number.

If there are more orders than the available stock, a ballot will be held on 18 February 2012.

Credit for the cost of the item will be granted to those who are unsuccessful in the ballot.

Discounts are available to AATTC members:

- 5% for orders over \$10.00
- Additional 5% for large orders over \$30, subject to adequate coverage of costs.

Contributions to the Distribution Service are always welcome, and can be sent to the Distributor Officer at PO Box 21 Yea, Victoria, 3717.

There are several ways in which this can be done.

- If you can send single copies of timetables and brochures, arrangements can then usually be made to request more copies from the operator.
- If you can obtain multiple copies, usually 10 copies are needed to cater for orders, but 15 copies are needed if the item is likely to be popular.

You can request to have the cost of postage for sending supplies for the Distribution Service granted as credit to your account.

If you are not sure about these arrangements, please contact the Distribution Officer by phone or email (details on page 1).

There have been significant increases in postal costs in recent times, especially parcel rates.

The 'traditional' cost of 50 cents (2 points) for a standard DL size timetable or brochure is no longer adequate to cover the costs of acquiring the stock, posting the order, and contributing to production overheads.

Hence, any item that is thicker than a simple A4 sheet folded to DL may be charged at 75 cents (3 points).

A thicker item, or any A4 or A5 item that cannot be folded to DL, may be charged at \$1.25 (5 points) to cover the minimum postage cost of \$1.20.

Each item is costed individually taking into account the quantity of stock available, costs incurred in obtaining the stock,

the likely popularity of the item, its size and weight, any costs of printing or photocopying, and postage of the order.

The discounts that apply to orders over \$10 and over \$30 take account of the cost saving in posting large orders.

Your **comments and suggestions** about the Distribution Service are appreciated.

They can help to improve the service for all members of the Australian Association of Timetable Collectors
