DISTRIBUTION LIST November 2012

The **AATTC Distribution Service** aims to supply as many current Australian timetables and information brochures as possible. It also provides historical material from Australia and overseas as it becomes available.

Changes to the Distribution Service

Following discussions in the last month and particularly at the AGM in Melbourne on 20 October 2012, the Distribution List will continue very much in its present form, but behind the scenes there are significant improvements.

The responsibility of compiling the monthly List and despatching the orders will now be shared by several Distribution Officers around Australia. These officers will retain the stock of items they collect and will despatch the individual orders.

The task of collating the Lists compiled by the various Distribution Officers will be handled at the Distribution Manager, a new position which is currently vacant. He will produce the consolidated List and despatch it as at present.

Your orders and payments will be sent to the Distribution Manager, and he will pass on the orders for individual items to the various Distribution Officers. Hence, your order may arrive in several envelopes.

For the time being, the Treasurer will handle the tasks of the Distribution Manager.

You will still place your order and make your payments in the same way as in the past. The Distribution Manager will advise you of your account balance after each order, preferably by email. All existing account balances remain and are not affected by these changes.

The November 2012 Distribution List is a transition to the new arrangements, and some of the details are still being worked out. More details about the Distribution Officers will be included in the December 2012 Distribution List.

If you wish to submit material for a future Distribution List, please contact the Distribution Manager to find out where to send it to.

Discussions are also underway to simplify the Auction procedures. At the AGM it was agreed that it would be worthwhile to include the Auction with the Distribution List and hold a much smaller Auction each month, rather than a large one at irregular intervals. The details of this arrangement will also be included with the December 2012 Distribution List.

Much of the material that was previously included in the Distribution List as 'Limited Stock' items will probably be listed through the new Auction arrangements.

This is a very satisfactory and positive outcome. The sharing of the workload will enable the Distribution List to continue to perform its important function as a key service to members. The AATTC Committee is grateful to all those who have come forward to make these new arrangements workable.

- **Status:** **O:** Original (or image copy of original quality). **Bc:** B&W image copy or print. **Cc:** colour print copy. **Web:** Print from website.
CF: Computer file. **CD, DVD:** Computer disc. **C:** Current. **NC:** Not Current. **?:** Current status not known
- **Size:** Finished page size. **DL, DLX, A3, A4, A5, A6, A7, B5:** Standard paper sizes. **+ or -:** larger or smaller than standard size. **FCap:** Foolscap **2A4:** Half A4. **4A4, 4A3:** Quarter A4, A3 (A4, A3 folded longways). Non-standard sizes are shown in millimetres.
P: Pocket size (~80x145mm). **W:** Wallet size (~65x95mm). **M:** Mini size (credit card). **F:** Folded
- **Pages:** Number of pages if stapled or glued.

Orders placed by email will be acknowledged within 5 days. If no acknowledgement is received, please re-send the order, as there may have been a breakdown in email transmission.

Limited Stock items are marked with an * in the first column in the Distribution List, beside the Item Number.

If there are more orders than the available stock, a ballot will be held on 17 November 2012.

Credit for the cost of the item will be granted to those who are unsuccessful in the ballot.

Payments for orders can be made by postage stamps, by money order or cheque payable to Australian Association of Timetable Collectors (AATTC), by PayPal to AATTC at aattc.do@hunterlink.net.au, or by EFT bank deposit to AATTC: Westpac BSB 034083, account 163088.

If paying by PayPal or EFT, please include your name in the message, and send an email to the Treasurer at aattc.do@hunterlink.net.au .

Discounts are available to AATTC members:

- 5% for orders over \$10.00
- Additional 5% for large orders over \$30, subject to adequate coverage of costs.

Contributions to the Distribution Service are always welcome. Please contact the Distribution Manager (currently the Treasurer) for information on where to send the material. Contact details are on page 1.

There are several ways in which this can be done.

- If you can send single copies of timetables and brochures, arrangements can then usually be made to request more copies from the operator.
- If you can obtain multiple copies, usually 10 copies are needed to cater for orders, but 15 copies are needed if the item is likely to be popular.

You can request to have the cost of postage for sending supplies for the Distribution Service granted as credit to your account.

Your **comments and suggestions** about the Distribution Service are appreciated.

They can help to improve the service for all members of the Australian Association of Timetable Collectors.

Items available as files

Where an item is available as a file, the code 'CF' (computer file) is shown in the Status column, with the appropriate number of cost points in the Points column.

Where an item is available in **print** and **file** formats, please indicate clearly which format you want.

Files are normally sent by email, but can request them to be posted on a CD for an extra \$2.50.
