Please contact Peter **if you do not receive your order within two weeks for email orders or three weeks for postage orders**.

Peter will forward your order to the Distribution Officers who hold the stock for the items ordered, and they will despatch the items. Their codes are shown in the first column of the Distribution List.

Payments attached to orders will be forwarded to the Treasurer.

All values are in whole dollars. Initial bids must be received by **20 March 2014**.

If submitting your bids by post, it is suggested that you advise the Auctioneer by phone or email in case the postal delivery is delayed.

For the Lots of your choice, write your bid in the 'Bid' column. It must be not less than the amount shown in the Reserve column.

If this is the only bid for a Lot, you will pay your bid price.

If there are multiple bidders, but no Alternate Bids for a Lot, the Lot is sold to the highest bidder at that bid price.

You can enter an Alternate Bid that you are prepared to pay in the 'Alt Bid' column.

If there is more than one bid for a Lot, the Alternate Bids are considered, and the item is sold to the highest Alternate Bid at that bid price.
