Australian Timetable Association Timetable Management Policies

National Timetable Collection

This aims to preserve one print copy of all timetables for all public transport modes in Australia. It also includes network maps, timetable changes and fares schedules.

The timetables are received from donations, from surpluses in the Distribution List, from unsold Auction items, and from Grab Boxes. Donors can request reimbursement of postage costs from the Treasurer.

Discussions are underway for the establishment of a digital national timetable collection.

Auctions

Timetables and other public transport items more than 10 years old are accepted – original prints only.

They can be submitted to the Auctioneer as Vendor. A Vendor receives 75% of the value of items sold at Auction. If not sold, they may be listed once again. If still unsold, the items go to the National Timetable Collection or the Distribution List.

Other material for the Auctions comes from surplus items from the Distribution Lists, National Timetable Collection and Grab Boxes.

Distribution List

Current timetables, older timetables not previously listed, operations and information documents, and public transport reports of general interest are accepted.

Original prints, good photocopies and computer file versions are accepted.

These items are collected in bulk if possible by Distribution Officers or sent by other members and friends to a Distribution Officer. Postage costs incurred can be claimed from the Treasurer. Some items also come from Auction and National Timetable Collection surpluses.

One copy of any suitable surplus items at the end of each month is allocated to the National Timetable Collection. The rest are made available for the Grab Box at an ATA meeting.

Archives

Significant timetables are retained in ATA Archives and are available on loan for research projects.

Surplus timetables are exchanged with the Victorian History Library at Prahran Mechanics Institute, Hawthorn Tram Museum and Sydney Bus Museum. Other surplus items are offered to appropriate preservation organisations.

Old Timetables

ATA has many uses for old timetables, so do not throw them away. Contact the Archives Officer, Len Regan, on 0409 209 114 or archives@austta.org.au to discuss what is best to do when you want to dispose of timetables.

Payments attached to orders will be banked into the ATA Account.

Costs: The dollar cost of each item is shown in the Cost column to indicate whether it is available as a print document, as a computer file, or in both formats. The costs are in multiples of 50c to make it easy for you to add up the cost of your order. The cost of packing and postage is included in these costs. The minimum cost for an order with print items is \$1.50.

ATA members get a discount of 5% for Distribution List orders for over \$10, and 10% for orders over \$30 subject to adequate coverage of costs, rounded to the nearest 5c.

Codes: Those in first row of an item relate to whole item. Codes in other rows relate to the document in that row.

Date: The start date for the service, otherwise the print date shown the item. () Exact Date Unknown

Status: **O:** Original (or image copy of original quality). **Bc:** B&W image copy or print. **Cc:** colour print copy. **Web:** Print from website.

CF: Computer file. **CD, DVD:** Computer disc. **C:** Current. **NC:** Not Current. **?:** Current status not known.

Size: Finished page size. **DL, DLX, A3, A4, A5, A6, A7, B5, B6:** Standard paper sizes. **+ or -:** varies from standard size.

FCap: Foolscap. **2A4:** Half A4. **4A4, 4A3:** Quarter A4, A3 (A4, A3 folded longways). Non-standard sizes are shown in millimetres.

P: Pocket size (~80x145mm). **W:** Wallet size (~65x95mm). **M:** Mini size (credit card). **F:** Folded.
