All values are in whole dollars. Initial bids must be received by 5pm Monday 20 July 2020.

If submitting your bids by post, you should advise the Auctioneer by phone or email in case the postal delivery is delayed.

For the Lots of your choice, write your bid in the 'Minimum Bid' column. It must be not less than the amount shown in the Reserve column. Also enter the maximum you are prepared to pay in the 'Maximum Bid' column. All bids should be in whole dollars.
