A reserve price has been set for each Lot, but is not shown in the Catalogue. The reserve price is slightly lower than the Estimate shown in the Catalogue.

The reserve price is based on the age and scarcity of the Lot. It does not include the cost of packaging and postage. All bids should be in whole dollars.

Lots will be sold to the person bidding the highest amount for each Lot, provided it meets the reserve price.

- 1. If the highest bid is 20% more than the second highest bid for a Lot, the Lot will be sold at 20% more than the second highest bid.
